BEYOND THE VOTE GUIDELINES FOR SCHOLARSHIPS

- Number of scholarships to be determined by the Beyond the Vote Committee
- \$1,500 scholarships awarded as determined and approved by the Committee
- Selection of the winning essay by the BTV review committee
- Presentation of the scholarship to be awarded by BTV committee, recipients presented at the TFRW Biennial Convention

ELIGIBILITY REQUIRMENTS

Female Applicant must:

- Submit a completed application form
 - Be a Republican voting resident of the State of Tennessee
 - Be an American Citizen for at least five (5) years
 - Be entering her Junior year of college
 - Be majoring in political science with a 3.0 minimum grade point
 - Have documented record of volunteer community service
 - Submit an essay of 500 words or less on “How the 19th Amendment has enhanced women's opportunities for leadership” (How has this impacted on you personally?)
- * Continue political science major and maintain 3.0 minimum grade point for Senior year of college
